Get creative with Adobe Express in SDUSD!



All SDUSD staff and students now have access to [Adobe Express](#) for Education. Adobe Express allows students in all subject areas to easily create unique graphics, design custom web pages, record video presentations, and more. Students can even make animations using the new [animate-from-audio tool](#).
To get started, [log in](#) and check out a few templates!

Students become creators with Adobe Express:

GRAPHICS: Design stunning presentations, images, and animations [\[Example\]](#)

It's easy to make science fair posters, social studies infographics, math flashcards, and so much more. Pick a template or start from scratch.

PAGES: Create attention-grabbing web pages [\[Example\]](#)

Transform weekly journals, language art essays, lab reports, unit projects and more into dynamic web stories. Choose a layout, theme, and fonts.

VIDEOS: Make captivating videos [\[Example\]](#)

Turn book reports, physics explainers, poetry analyses, and more into video presentations. Narrate your story, pick a theme, then customize.

There are two primary ways to seamlessly log in to Adobe Express using your SDUSD credentials:

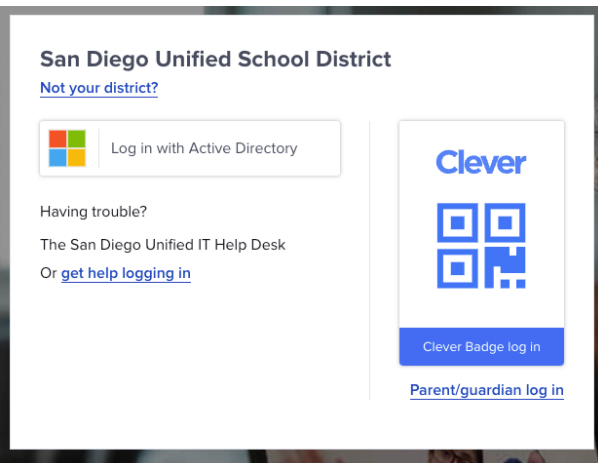

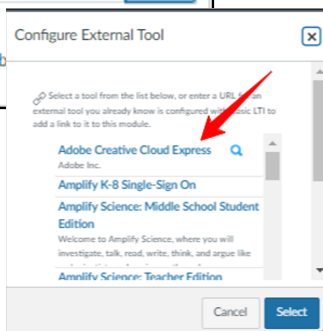
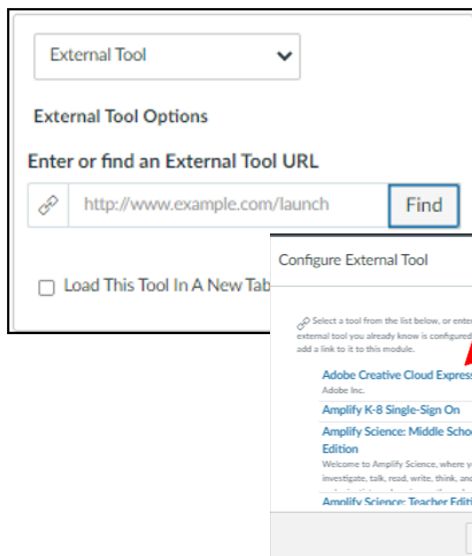


Does Adobe Express work within Canvas?

Yes! With the Adobe Express Canvas Integration, teachers can assign customized project templates to classes using the External Tool. Students can submit directly to Canvas and teachers can grade projects directly within Canvas SpeedGrader.

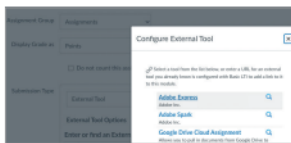


What can I do with Canvas/Adobe Express integration?

With the Adobe Express assignment integration in Canvas, you can empower your students to customize or create their own graphics, posters, videos, web pages, and visual reports all within your existing assignment flow.

Follow these easy steps to unleash your students' creativity:

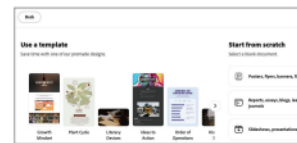
1. Once you've started a new Canvas assignment and filled in the details, scroll down to **Submission Type**. Select **External Tool** and then choose **Adobe Express**.



2. You'll be signed in to Adobe Express using your district credentials, and a browser window will come up. If you've used Adobe Express before, your projects will be listed in the window.



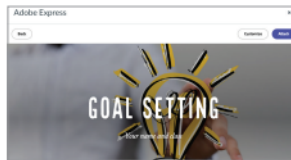
3. Either choose an existing project from your Adobe Express library, or click the **Projects** button to start a new project from scratch.



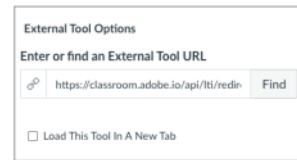
4. Customize a new project to meet the needs of your lesson using one of the thousands of available educational templates.



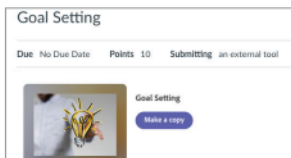
5. Once your asset/project is ready, return to Canvas and click on the thumbnail for the asset you want to assign to students. Click **attach**.



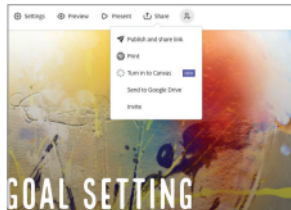
6. **DO NOT** check the box labeled **Load This Tool in A New Tab**. Simply save and publish the assignment.



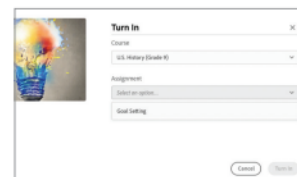
7. When your students view their Canvas assignment, they will have the option to **Make a Copy** of that asset in Adobe Express. They can then use their creativity and knowledge to customize the template.



8. When they are ready to submit the project, they click **Share** and **Turn in to Canvas**.



9. They can then select their class to turn in and finish the submission process all within Adobe Express without having to go back to Canvas.



10. Once a student submits, you will see their submission within the Canvas **Assignment** tab. A copy of their project will be shown within the submission window, allowing you to use SpeedGrader to grade and provide feedback directly within Canvas.
